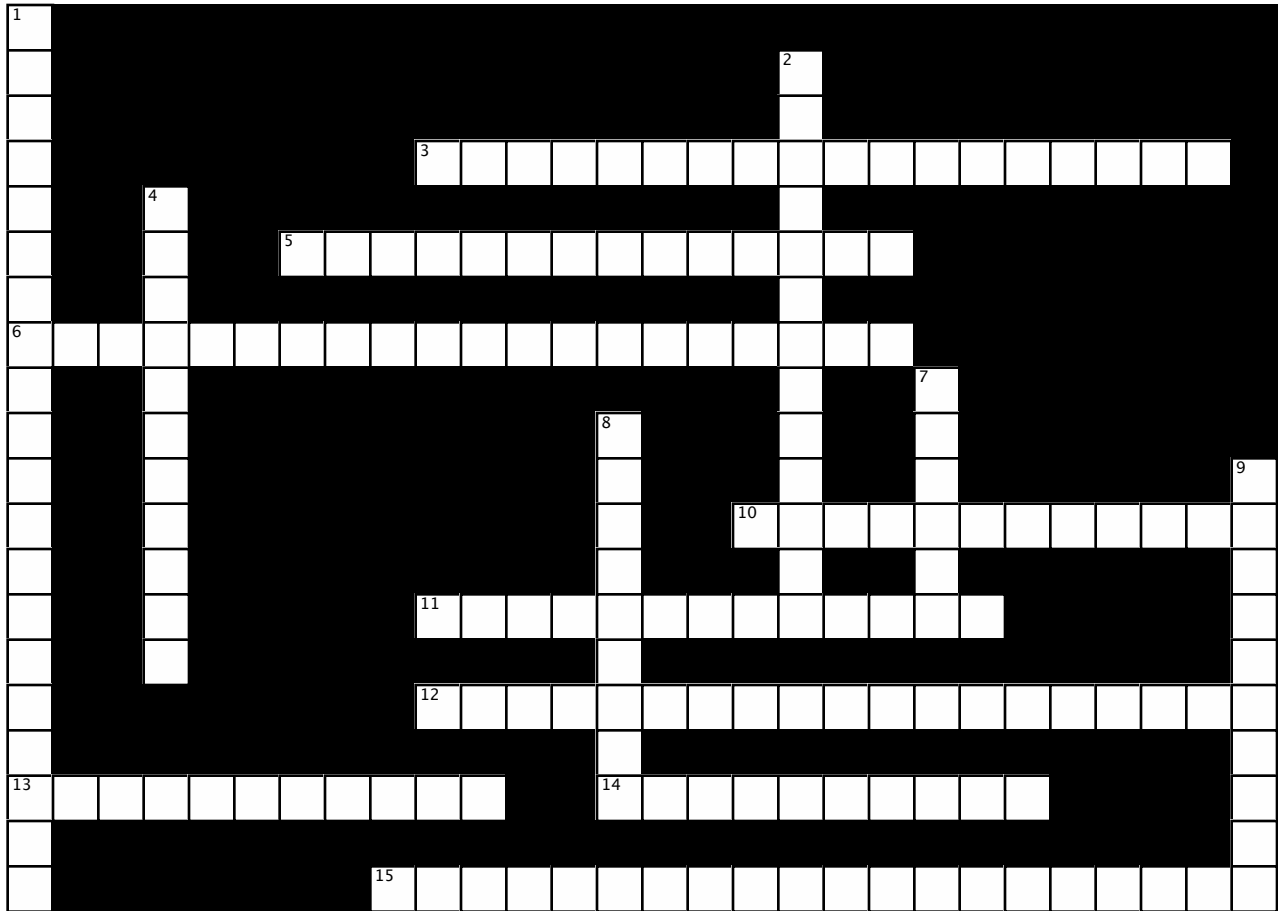


Soups, Salads & One-Dish Meals
